This is a Double Elimination, Multiple Game Tournament.

There will be "BYES" to fill a 32-player chart, including ladies and seniors.

Players on a team, which on 1/1/24, was in the top 2 teams of their local league are considered "A" Singles. Players in the top 1/3 of their local league {but not 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup>} are considered "B" Singles. Teams in the middle 1/3 are "C" Singles, and the bottom 1/3 are "D" Singles. Ladies, regardless of their team standing, are eligible for the "LADIES" Singles.

Players who have been ranked by VNEA or PAMMA/VNEA MUST play at, or above their ranking.

Placement into team divisions will be by local league standings as of January 1, 2024 or known ability. Singles play is broken down into multiple divisions for Friday night. In each division the players are grouped into 32 seeded charts, based on their league straight average {total balls/total games} to 2 decimal points. Players may play "up" a division, but they may not play below their team division, nor may they play below their personal listed rank, as shown on the "Ranking Sheet" for players who have cashed in recent years. Example: Player X plays on a "D" team {bottom 1/3 in their local league} she may play any division she chooses. Player Y plays on the same "D" team, but she is ranked as an "A" player, she may not play "D" team and may only play "A" singles. Player Z plays on a "B" team {top1/3} he may not play "D" or "C" singles but is eligible in "B" or "A" singles.



## **SINGLES PLAY BEGINS AT 2:00 PM**

Rules: The Valley National 8-Ball rules book will be followed throughout the tournament, with the following exceptions:

- 1. All judgement calls/disputes will be settled by the tournament director, without appeal.
- 2. Opponents will be determined by a draw, seeded to avoid play of same leagues in the first 2 rounds.
- No handicaps will be used.
- 4. Any player 15 minutes late to a match shall forfeit.
- 5. Players are responsible for calling all fouls and froze balls and registering objections. When in doubt ask a referee to watch the shot!
- 6. Tournament rule for 8 ball on break is either a rerack or can be spotted.
- 7. The first break shot in each match is determined by a coin toss. Each succeeding break shot in the match shall be made by alternating teams. The team that wins the toss will break 8 out of 15 games. One team designated to keep score and opposing team shall verify. Opposing team captain shall sign score sheets
- 8. As soon as a win is guaranteed the match is over.
- 9. At the tournament director discretion, teams will be moved into other divisions according to their known skill levels. All Ladies teams can play in "D" division. There is exception. Last year's placed teams will be ranked. {see tourney results and ranked player listing}
- 10. Jumping is allowed.
- 11. Any Un-sportsman like conduct will not be accepted under any circumstances. You will be asked to leave, and you will forfeit your money!
